

YANKTON COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING
December 22, 2009

The regular meeting of the Yankton County Commission was called to order by Chairman Bruce Jensen at 4:30 PM on Tuesday, December 22, 2009.

Roll Call was taken with the following Commissioners present: Donna Freng, Bruce Jensen, Mark Johnson, Allen Sinclair. Commissioner Bill Tamisiea was absent.

Action 09493C: A motion was made by Sinclair and seconded by Freng to set the agenda with the following additions/changes: Petition for Road Vacation Architectural contract
Voting Aye: All Nay: None Motion carried.

Action 09494C: A motion was made by Freng and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the December 1st, 2009 meeting of the Board.
Voting Aye: All Nay: None Motion carried.

No indigent requests were presented to the Board.

Jeremy Dangel, Emergency Management Director, advised the Board of the impending blizzard and the measures in place for addressing emergencies.

Action 09495C: A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Sinclair to recess the regular meeting of the Board and convene in Executive Session to address a personnel matter.

Action 09496C: A motion was made by Freng and seconded by Sinclair to reconvene in regular session.

Chairman Jensen announced no action would be taken as a result of the Executive Session.

The ambulance report for the month of November 2009 was presented by Steve Hawkins. The department responded to 1115 calls in November with 103 1st calls, 9 2nd/3rd calls, 3 standbys and 14 transfers. \$76,526 was billed out in November and \$46,778 was received in for November. Hawkins advised the Commission that the year-to-date cost per resident of Yankton County for ambulance services is 1.23 cents. Year-to-date expenditures were \$571,458 and receipts were \$545,075.

Hawkins advised Randy Webert has been promoted to the position of Training Officer for the Ambulance Service and Tina Monteith has been hired as a Senior Paramedic.

Smith is investigating the various underwriter options and will report back to the Commission. The County is currently insured with the SDML for workmen's compensation coverage and with EMC Insurance Company for liability coverage.
